Report on National Webinar

GRIIPP - The Research Pillars

07-08 September 2021

A two-day national webinar on 'GRIIPP – The Research Pillars" was organized on 07 and 08th September 2021 by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Baburaoji Gholap College, Sangvi on the occasion of the 80th anniversary of the Pune District Education Board. The webinar was inaugurated by Dr. Kiran Kumar Bondar, Joint Director of Higher Education Department, Pune. Treasurer of Pune District Education Board Adv. Mohanrao Deshmukh presided over the inaugural function. Principal Dr. Nitin Ghorpade, Vice Principal Dr. Latesh Nikam, IQAC Coordinator Dr. Sangeeta Jagtap was present. The webinar was inaugurated with digital lamp lighting using modern technology.

'Students need to understand the criteria of the National Institutional Nominating Organization when publishing a research publication. Also, to make research more effective, research students need to focus on qualitative research rather than quantitative research', asserted By Dr. Bondar at the inauguration of webinar. While introducing the webinar, the principal of the college Dr. Nitin Ghorpade explained the purpose and importance of this national webinar organized on the occasion of Pune District Education Board's anniversary. Also expressing the opinion that higher education will play a decisive role in creating skilled human resources and raising the economic level of the country, he explained the importance of quality research for national development.

In his presidential guidance, Treasurer of Pune District Education Association, Adv. Mohanrao Deshmukh congratulated the college for organizing a two-day national webinar on the anniversary of the institute. He also explained the importance of research in the field of education by giving information about the work done by the Pune District Education Board to provide quality education to students from the poor and Bahujan communities. The inaugural session was moderated by Dr. Medha Misar and Dr. By Latesh Nikam.

A keynote speaker for the first technical session of the webinar was Dr. Alok Verma, a Senior Scientist from Sameer Institute working under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Government of India. While guiding on the topic 'Acquaintance and attainment of Grants and Resources' he gave information about the type of sources of funds that are identified as government, private industrial sector, organizations, and professional bodies. He emphasized on the statistical analysis of the research and development sector in India, investment in it, share in per capita income from the identified government, private industrial sector, associations, and business organizations. He also stated that universities are major centers of research and gave informations about the funds released by University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Defense Research

and Development Organization (DRDO), Department of Nuclear, Department of Biotechnology, Indian Council of Health Research, Ministry of Information Technology etc. in addition he highlighted the funding provided by the Ministry of Environment, the various programs and schemes run by various Ministries for development, and some other available sources of funds. Dr. Dyaneshwar Mahajan introduced the guests for this session while Mrs. Amrita Inamdar expressed the vote of thanks. Dr. Rani Bhagat took charge of the question-and-answer session.

The second technical session of the webinar was addressed by Dr. Mahendra Shirasath, Director of National Higher Education Mission and Head of Electronics Department, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. He guided audience on the topic 'Incubation - a centre to innovate novel Ideas for new ventures' and gave detailed information about Criteria 3, which is an important part of research-related NAAC. In this session Dr. Mahendra Shirasath elaborated on the factors of promotion of research and facilities, resource mobilization for research, innovation ecosystem, research publications and awards, consultancy, extension activities among the criteria of research, innovation and extension, and stakeholders, especially research students, need to pay attention to quality research. Dr. Praveen Yawale introduced the speaker of this session, while Dr. Manisha Shewale assisted the question and answer session and Dr. Kranti Borawke proposed vote of thanks.

Principal of Pimpri Chinchwad College of Engineering and Research, Dr. Harish Tiwari guided the third session on 'Comprehend, Protect and Channelize unique ideas towards Intellectual Property'. He discussed in detail about the 5 trillion dollar economy and its challenges, current situation, comparative study of US and Chinese economy, share of agriculture and service sector and active participation of students, teachers and women in this concept. Along with this, information was given on intellectual property, various start up schemes for students and innovative concepts, patents and procedures required for the same. For the said session, Dr. Yogesh Khollam introduced the lecturers while Dr. Seema Chauhan conducted the question and answer session and Dr. Satish Ekar expressed the vote of thanks.

In the fourth and final session of the webinar, Vice President of Academia Nagpur Dr. Prashant Borkar gave a presentation on 'Research Ethics and Platforms for Righteous Publication' discussing important elements of research essay, discussion, summary, context, future importance, research funding agencies, fake journals etc. For this final session Dr. Vijay Ghadge conducted the question and answer session. Dr. Narsingh Giri and Dr. Chanda Hase introduced and thanked the lecturers respectively.

During valedictory function, Joint Secretary (Administration) of Pune District Education Association, Mr. A. M. Jadhav congratulated the college for organizing this webinar on a very innovative concept. He expressed the opinion that the guidance of experts in such seminars helps to stay up-to-date and wished that the information obtained should be converted into actual work.
